  - o Intent to return knowledge may help with space needed to safely have full-time return

  - o Concern of loss of funding if students drop out to return to town districts
  - Many teachers didn't want to go back when explored before
  - Draft letter to the Board of Trustees by Feb 11<sup>th</sup>
