- Why? Give students the opportunity to be able to zoom in 40X on a macroscopic object will be beneficial to learning (and fascinating) for them to see them on a completely different level

• <u>15 Month Membership to LiteracyPro</u> - Scholastic Literacy Program (Re-Visit from April meeting)



- Why? This program contains a digital library of books for K-8 students as well as reading assessment tools for teachers to assess student progress. It will help build students' independent reading skills by providing a wide variety of high interest books with diverse protagonists and authors. It also allows teachers to track and monitor students' progress, interests, comprehension, and engagement with these texts. Teachers will be able to use this program as the basis for an Independent Reading curriculum, a replacement/addition to their classroom library (since many are not available due to COVID-19), or both. Independent, free choice reading is crucial to student achievement in reading, writing, and building a lifelong love of reading. It also builds empathy and social-emotional skills.
- Who will benefit? Kids in grades K-8

- How much will it cost? 2 Options
 - Storia (K-6): \$2,900. All titles in Literacy Pro, but without the student assessments and tracking data for teachers. OR

 - We've also been offered the program for 15 months for a 12-month membership price, so we could purchase it at the beginning of the school year and use it through the summer for kids to use for summer reading.

- I also intend to share microscope usage with other Level IV and Level III science teachers as it suits their curriculum since these are expensive items that should be shared among teachers.
- I expect that any student who wants to take a closer look at an object will want to use the microscopes- they will be more than welcome to! Most people do not have access to a microscope in their daily lives, and if a student passing by on the first day of school wants to start by looking at their finger, then they will be allowed that. Perhaps someone will find something outside at recess and want to take a closer look at it-I would love to have these microscopes used in structured classes, slightly less structured project and FIT time, and very unstructured times when someone just wants to see an object up close.

I am requesting funds to purchase 4 of these stereo microscopes for regular classroom use: https://www.amscope.com/binocular-dissecting-microscope-20x-40x.html

These microscopes will be primarily used in my Entomology Project. In addition to learning about the evolutionary history of insects, students will learn how to create their own professional insect collection. They will learn the standard techniques of insect collection, preservation, and identification methods; to facilitate this, I will need microscopes for students to share* in my classroom. Many diagnostic characteristics are not visible even with a hand lens; being able to zoom in 40X on a macroscopic object will be beneficial (and fascinating) for them. In this project, students will also be involved in Citizen Science monitoring for invasive insects in our area.

Stereo microscopes are also helpful in identifying certain plant structures and in aquatic insects (from the stream behind 100 Longwater)- this will be part of a back-yard biodiversity themed FIT.

*We will, of course, use disinfecting wipes between different people using the same microscope.


