¹This language aligns with CDC school guidance and the DESE FAQ released on 5/17. Certain circumstances that require increased cleaning or disinfecting include communities with higher COVID-19 transmission, areas of low masking, when surfaces are visibly soiled, and if someone confirmed to have COVID-19 was in the facility.
