## 5. Additional Topics

- School Council update
  - o Update from the previous School Council Meeting on Feb 10th 4:30PM-5:15PM
  - Reviewed updated draft of the school improvement plan, highlights include:
    - Anti-racism education This is an important goal for all areas of the school. A group of 30 teachers and administrators attended the National Anti-Racism Teach In (NART) summit. The administrative team is reading/has read the book "Grading for Equity". This is important and should be\_included as an overall goal as well as be imbedded within each academic area otherwise it gets overlooked.
    - The "School to Family" (Strengthen digital communication between home and school) benchmarks were updated from last year and now read in draft form:
      - Schedule a virtual monthly Principal's Coffee and place on the website calendar, fall
        2021
      - Plan for family meetings, parent-teacher conferences, and school events taking into consideration which events have worked well virtually during the pandemic, summer 2022
      - Create a new digital report card for grades K-4, summer 2022
        - K-4 Report Cards School is evaluating an update to the report card process and tools used. Discussion amongst faculty and parents on what they like and dislike about the information shared in this format and the process to create and review them. Angie and team will be doing benchmarking process to assess alternative options and share them back with this group for feedback at a future meeting.
      - Continue use of social media for communication, ongoing
      - Support students in organizing and prioritizing their digital communications, ongoing
    - The Family Engagement (Assess the current state of the community and plan for increased family involvement in the school) benchmarks read as follows:
      - Increase the diversity of parents involved in school related activities by drawing on digital resources, ongoing
      - Create structures to connect students at the town/community level, ongoing
      - Assess interest in current family outreach events and make changes to reflect current interests, ongoing

- Reestablish the INPAC (Inclusive Parent Advisory Council) group and establish an ELPAC (English Learner Advisory Council) to increase parent voices in Special Education and English Learner programming, ongoing
- One specific place that the school is asking for help from the PA is with the Relationship Building focus area. This goal reads as:
  - Support students in their ability to form and maintain healthy relationships; foster healing from the trauma caused by the COVID-19 pandemic
- The school is also asking if the PA could help brainstorm some community building events for the spring and next year.
