School Bus Driver Part-time located in Holbrook, MA

Guaranteed 24 hours per week at \$24.00hr during the school year: paid school vacations: Hours are a split shift approximately 6:15am – 8:30 and 2:00pm to 4:30 except early release days being 11:00am – 1:30pm.

Operate a full-size school bus that transports students from K-12<sup>th</sup> with and without disabilities to and from school.

**QUALIFICATIONS** Valid Massachusetts Class B drivers license with S and P endorsements Valid DOT School Bus Certificate: Must be 21 years of age. Ability to follow written and verbal instructions in English. Ability to communicate effectively. Ability to manage student behavior.

**EXAMPLES OF DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**: <u>Vehicle Operation</u>: Follow assigned route and adhere to established schedules. Check bus for mechanical defects before and after each operation and notify supervisor of needed repairs. Report all accidents, vehicle damage, student injuries, mechanical failure, and complete required reports. Keep records on bus for mileage, gas and oil consumption, and number of passengers transported. Keep assigned bus clean and fueled. Inspect bus by checking fuel, oil, water, tires, lights, brakes, and steering to ensure bus can be operated safely before driving. <u>Safety</u>: Observe all traffic laws and safety regulations for school buses. Ensure proper condition of emergency equipment, such as first aid kit, fire extinguisher, fuses, and reflectors.

Learn and adapt to each students special medical, physical, communicative, and emotional needs. Supervise students as they board and leave bus and cross the street. Maintain discipline and report student discipline problems to supervisor. Instruct students on safe riding rules and regulations.

## COVID Testing

- 3 types of testing
  - Symptomatic

- Test & Stay (close contact testing)
- Weekly COVID Safety Testing
- You must pre-register to be eligible for testing (if you registered last year, you must reregister as it is a different log on)
- Due to volume of people registering, you may not be able to register same day if you are contacted – so consider registering today. <u>https://pbcovid.cic-health.com/register/withcode?code=KDHEHV</u>
- You may opt out of a specific type of testing after registering by contacting the school nurse in writing
- o As of Friday, 9/17 188 students have been registered.
